MBBS Fee Structure

Directorate General of Medical Education (DGME), under the Medical Education and Family Welfare Division of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW) has prescribed the fees of MBBS courses in private medical colleges for Bangladeshi students. As per the decision of the memorandum the fee's structure are as follows:

- a) MBBS Admission Fee: BDT 19,44,000/-
- b) Internship Fee: BDT 1,80,000/-
- c) Tuition Fee: BDT 10,000/-

The Admission and Internship fee collection method is as follows:

- 1st Step (60%) - At the time of admission
- 2nd Step (20%) - During 1st Professional Exam Time
- 3rd Step (20%) - During 3rd Professional Exam Time

Payments

As per the government prescribed tuition fee structure, RCMC follows the official payment procedures, and all the tuition fees must be paid on a monthly basis.
